

Lowell Collaborative Preschool Academy is Now Enrolling!!!



Lowell Public Schools, Community Teamwork, and Little Sprouts will be hosting a **NEW** Preschool program called the **Lowell Collaborative Preschool Academy** located at 554 Pawtucket Street in Lowell. This preschool program has limited seats available and is open to children living in Lowell that are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines and have not had an opportunity to attend any preschool program in the past. **The program is scheduled to begin fall of 2015.**

Who is eligible for this FREE, full-day, full-year program?

If you have a child who is:

- A resident of Lowell and will be 4 years old by September 1, 2015 (born between September 2, 2010 and September 1, 2011)
- Your child has **NOT** attended a preschool/center based program, family childcare or Early Head Start/Head Start program

If you provide:

- Proof of income/eligibility (refer to chart on back)
- **TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED**

Based on your family size, your annual income must not exceed the following Poverty Guidelines:
