# **Supplies**

Marshmallows Toothpicks

### **Directions**

Put the marshmallows and toothpicks out and let the kids build. You can demonstrate how to build a square or triangle, or leave it totally up to them.

If your child is school aged, you can challenge them to:
Create the tallest building without falling
Create the sturdiest building without breaking
Build a structure that can hold the most weight
Create a variety of 3-D shapes
This is a fun STEM activity for any age, and you can create a challenge, or just leave it open for creative play.
