# Bubbles

Bubbles are a great outdoor activity for children! The bubbles can be used indoors but be careful of recipes with sugar or corn syrup, they may leave a sticky residue. There are plenty of homemade bubble recipes, here are a few to try. Some are really simple with ingredients you may already have at home, a few have ingredients that are more obscure.

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## Basic Homemade Bubble Recipe

1 cup water

1 tablespoon Dawn dishwashing liquid (or any other kind of dish washing liquid, but we found that Dawn or Joy worked the best).

### How to make

Combine water and dishwashing liquid in a cup. Stir gently and thoroughly to combine. Dip your bubble wand and get started!

## Deluxe Bubble Recipe

1 quart (4 cups) warm water

1/2 cup sugar (sugar makes the bubbles stick and last longer).

1/2 cup dishwashing liquid

### How to Make

Combine warm water and sugar, stir until sugar is fully dissolved

Add dishwashing liquid and stir again.

Store in an airtight container



## Crazy Deluxe Bubbles

1 cup warm water

2 tablespoons liquid dishwashing soap

1 tablespoons glycerin

1 teaspoon white sugar

### How to Make

Gently stir all ingredients together and store in an airtight container.

## Jello Bubble Recipe

1 part dishwashing liquid

1 part Jello- any flavor

### How to Make

Gently combine all ingredients. Avoid creating suds by mixing to vigorously. Suds will affect the "bubbliness" of you bubbles.

## Beautiful Bubbles

1/3 cup dishwashing liquid 1 1/4 cup water

2 teaspoons sugar

1 drop food coloring

### How to make

Combine all ingredients. Use outside to avoid staining carpets and upholstery.

## BUBBLE WANDS

Experiment with different wands. You can try:

Wire hangers (bend them into any shape you want)

Pipe cleaners

Yarn

Cookie cutters

Strainers

Winks

Each wand produces a different kind of bubble, try them all and see!
