HOUSING DISCRIMINATION IS ILLEGAL

Were you refused housing or treated differently because of your family? The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination based on who is or is not in your family. Refusal to rent to families with young children is against the law.

Housing discrimination may look like this:

- “this house is only for adults”
- “great place for young married couple”
- “I’d rent to you, but there is lead paint.”
